Station Recipe Guidelines

Firehouse food tells a story — tradition, teamwork, long nights, and shared wins. As part of **Firepenny Funds**, we're inviting stations to submit a recipe that represents *your crew*.

This guide walks you through **exactly how to submit your recipe**, step by step.

What We're Looking For

We're not judging Michelin-star plating. We want:

- Station favorites
- Shift classics
- Comfort food
- Weird-but-legendary meals
- Recipes that bring your crew together

If your station would argue over who makes it best — it belongs here.

Recipe Submission Requirements

Each recipe submission **must include all of the following**:

1. Recipe Name

Give it the name your station actually uses.

Examples:

- “Engine 7 Chili”
- “Midnight Tour Chicken”
- “Truck House Breakfast Skillet”

2. Written Recipe (Required)

Submit a clearly written recipe that includes:

- **Full ingredient list**
- **Usable measurements** (cups, tablespoons, pounds, etc.)
- **Step-by-step instructions**
- **Servings or batch size** (if known)

Please avoid:

- “Eyeball it”
- “A splash”
- “Cook until it feels right”

(We love the vibes — we just need something others can actually follow.)

3. Finished Dish Photo (Required)

Include **at least one photo** of the completed dish.

Photo tips (not mandatory, but helpful):

- Natural station lighting is fine
- Phone photos are totally acceptable
- Show the full dish if possible
- Action shots or crew involvement = bonus points

No stock photos, please. Follow the suggested food photography link on the Firepenny Funds website for more help.

4. Optional Add-Ons (Encouraged)

These aren't required, but they help bring your recipe to life:

- A short story behind the dish
- When it's usually made (holiday, night tour, after a call, etc.)
- Who in the station is known for making it
- A group photo or behind-the-scenes shot

File Format & Naming

Please submit recipes in the following formats:

- Provided recipe submission PDF.
- If you run out of room you may attach a second document.

Photos should be:

- JPG or PNG format
- Clearly labeled (station name/city, and recipe title.)

Example file names:

- SeattleStation12_Chili_Recipe.pdf
- TusconLadder3_Pasta_Photo1.jpg

How to Submit

Email all recipe materials to:

Include in your email:

- Station / Department name
- Contact name & email
- Recipe title
- Attached recipe file
- Attached photo(s)

You'll receive a confirmation email once your submission is received.

- Firepenny may format or lightly edit recipes for clarity and branding
- Submitting a recipe does **not** guarantee selection, but it **does** count toward your Firepenny Funds entry
